How to Participate:

4. Select one of your books and be prepared to discuss the following questions when you return to school:
 - a. How does the story connect to you?
 - b. How does the story connect to your community?
 - c. How does the story connect to the world?
 - d. Select the most meaningful passage from your text to support your ideas.
5. You may also be asked to connect ideas in your summer reading to a writing assignment for quarter 1.
