Battle of the Books is a reading incentive program from the Baltimore County Public Library for students in 3rd thru 12th grades and are leveled for elementary, middle, and high school teams. Students read books and come together in groups to demonstrate their abilities and to test their knowledge of the books they have read. There will be a competition, usually in April and similar to Family Feud, where our student groups will face off against other middle schools.

We meet every Tuesday to provide time to read, discuss reading progress, share reflections and opinions about the books, and to practice for the competition.

Attendance is not necessary as a Schoology group will be created in order to allow for online book chats with teammates!

Dates may be added or changed as needed throughout the year. Students should listen to the school announcements for updated information.
